




Running advanced workload in the cloud accelerated, demonstrating growing user confidence

25% growth in the number of advanced users clearly indicates an upward trend in cloud usage and adoption.






While there are many motivating factors to move to the cloud, performance and scalability rank the highest

Performance and scalability, ease of data access, and minimization of overall cost take top spots.






As organizations move to the cloud, having a clear idea about deployment model makes the journey easier

However, hybrid cloud has become somewhat of a standard for cloud deployments, with more than one-third of participants leading with it.






A concentrated market: Top three cloud service providers have 80% market share

There are no surprises in terms of top cloud service providers, while there may be some regional influences.






Architects are the most demanded role in the cloud

Close to 50% of participants expressed a demand for data and cloud architect roles, closely followed by the demand for a DevOps and Cloud administrator, at 33%.

In-Demand Cloud Role






BI and data integration are the top cloud use cases

Top Cloud Initiatives/Use Cases






Demand for data integration in the cloud is driven by data lakes and cloud data warehouses!


Close to 50% of participants leverage multiple solutions such as data lakes and data warehouses for data management in the cloud.
